

PLAT OF PUBLIC CEMETERY - WATERTOWN, MINN.

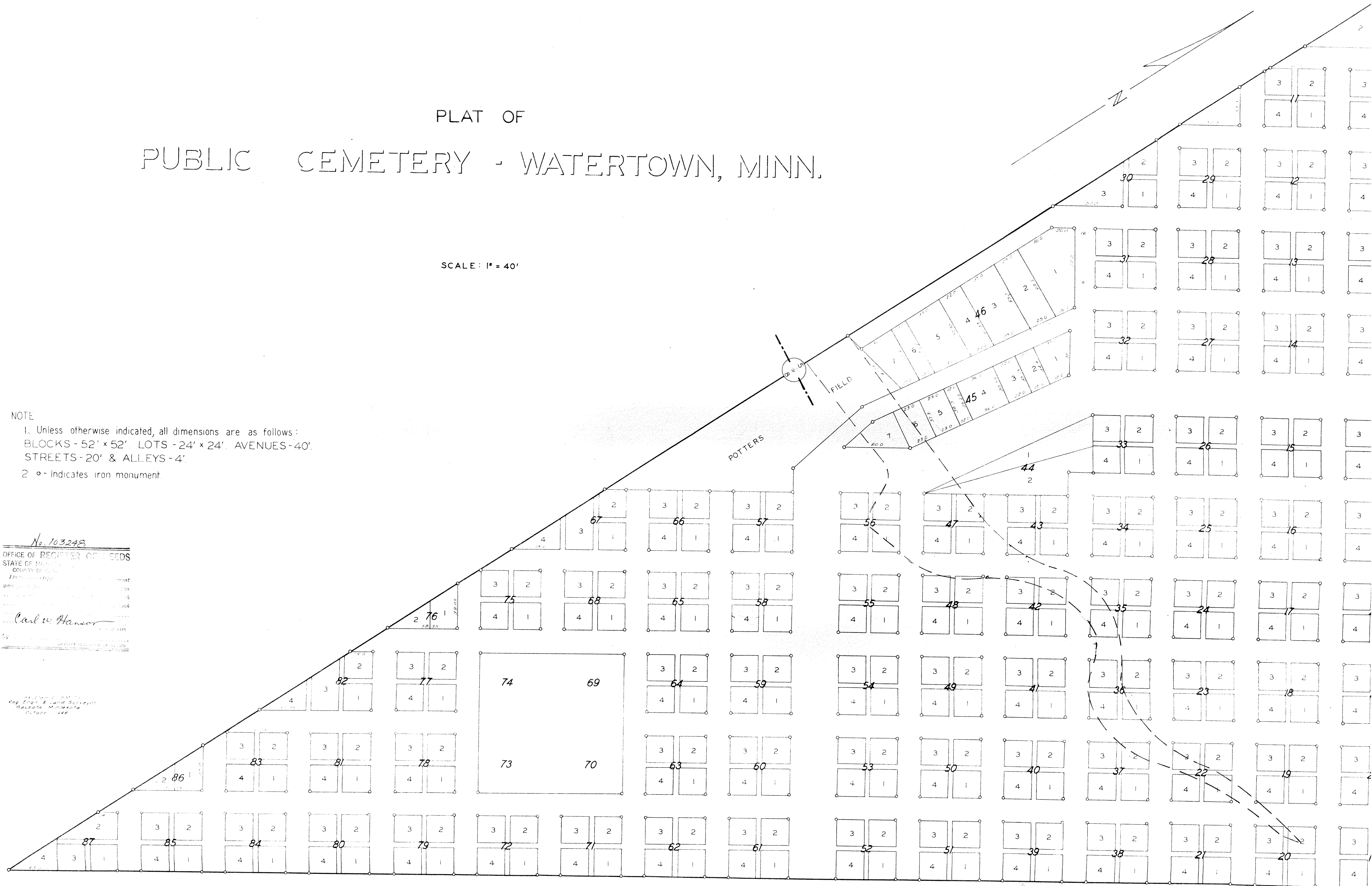
